## **Bulls Kid Nation Youth Hoops Health and Safety Protocols**

#### **Spectators**

#### General Protocols/Rules

- Each participant will be allowed a maximum of one (1) spectator for the program.
- This spectator must be fully vaccinated against COVID-19 (at least 2 weeks after a second dose was administered) and must show proof of vaccination in order to enter the facility. Negative tests will not be accepted for spectators for these programs, only proof of full vaccination against COVID-19.
- This spectator must also sign a waiver acknowledging this prior to entering the gym.
- If a spectator can not show proof of full vaccination, they will not be allowed in the gym but can drop the participant off outside of the building and pick them up without entering the building at the end of the program.

### Mask Policy

- Masks, while recommended, will be optional.
- Extra masks will be available for those who need them.

### Social Distancing

• Spectators (1 per participant) will be allowed to stay during the clinic, but we ask that spectators sit socially distanced from others while seated when possible.

# **Participants**

# General Protocols/Rules

- Participant must be fully vaccinated against COVID-19 (at least 2 weeks after a second dose was administered) and must show proof of vaccination in order to enter the facility. Negative tests will not be accepted for spectators for these programs, only proof of full vaccination against COVID-19.
- The parent/guardian of this participant must also sign a waiver acknowledging this for their child prior to entering the gym.
- Stations will be spaced out to encourage social distancing at each station.
- Hand sanitizing stations will be placed throughout the court.
- All participants will need to bring their own water bottles. No sharing of water bottles or cups will be permitted.
- If anyone is showing signs of illness the day of the program, we will ask that they refrain from coming to camp and a full refund will be given.
- If someone begins to feel ill or show signs of illness after arriving at the program, we will move them to an isolated spot within the venue if no parent is present and the parent will be contacted immediately. If a parent or guardian is present, we will move the child showing symptoms through a path not near others to exit the building.

- Once the individual has been isolated or has left the building, affected areas of the arena will be closed until it can be sanitized. Groups will not be allowed to use the areas until it is sanitized and everyone will be moved to other areas of the arena to continue the program.
- If a positive test is confirmed, local health authorities will be notified to begin the contact tracing process. Bulls Youth Hoops will work in coordination with local health officials to assist in any areas of the contact tracing process.

#### Mask Policy

- Masks, while recommended, will be optional.
- Extra masks will be available for those who need them.

### Social Distancing

• Social distancing will be enforced, when possible, throughout the clinic by coaches and staff.
